The family is all in danger if he catches the Covid flu.

Also his Mom, **Patrice Connell** needs to be careful for she is a hospital nurse and has 4-5 patients per shift that are not tested for the Covid before they come on the floor. She only wear a surgical mask, which does no good if they actually have that flu. She also has to be careful when around others. She wears an N95 mask when outside of the house in case she also contagious and do not know it

It would help boost **Sean's** moral if he was to receive mail from the church family here in Idaho, she said yes, he would love that. One of the things I love about my Dalton Gardens family is how you never miss a chance to be a light in someone else's darkness.
